

Preparation for video clinics for therapists

1. Make sure families have at least 1 days' notice to prepare for the consultation.
2. Have a telephone number available in case of system difficulties.
3. Send out a list of starting positions for parents before the appointment or use a doll to demonstrate positions.
4. Make sure that a room is booked for the clinic in advance and that it is clear to other staff that there is a virtual assessment taking place and there should be no interruptions.
5. Reassure the families they are doing things correctly and give feedback.
6. Make sure the consultation is well finished, plan the next appointment, review concerns and send a written summary
7. Make sure the families have a method of making contact and know that medical teams are still functioning for them
